

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is my BlueGolf Username and Password?

A: Your Username and Password are automatically generated by BlueGolf when you joined the WMGA. Call the office, (914) 592-7888 to receive an e-mail with your information.

Q: What do I do if I have to cancel and cannot play in an event?

A: Contact the WMGA office immediately.

Q: How do I find out if an event is cancelled due to weather or course conditions?

A: Check www.wmga.com, call the WMGA office, or call the host club's pro shop.

Q: How can I get a partner for a partner event if I don't have one?

A: Contact the WMGA office to request a partner for an event. We will keep a running list and pair individuals as requests are made.

Q: How do I know if I am entered in an event?

A: First, you receive a "registration acknowledgement" email, and second, you receive an "acceptance" or not email. You can also go to our website, click "Tournaments," and then click on the event to check your status.

Tournament Registration opens on April 1. To register, go to our website www.wmga.com and log into your BlueGolf account. You can select a partner for some events or sign up as a "single." Tips for Tournaments

The tournament entry fee includes continental breakfast and lunch, the golf competition, and access to the range and practice area. When you receive your starting time, make sure to allow plenty of time for travel, breakfast, and the practice range. You must be at the first tee ready to play ten minutes before your starting time. The WMGA encourages walking.; however, you can take a cart. You will pay for the caddie and/or cart on the day of play. The WMGA provides gratuities for the caddie master and locker room attendants, but if you receive special care, additional tipping is encouraged.

Code of Conduct

Each member is expected to conduct herself in a manner that fosters good sportsmanship, good fellowship, and respect for the game. You are expected to follow club rules and act as a grateful guest. We know you will always promote the best interest and traditions of the game of golf.

Membership

Your membership is in effect as long as you remain in good standing at your club and have access to your golf course at least four days per week for a minimum of three months during the season. Membership renewal takes place in November and is handled by your Met Rep who will contact you. If not, please contact the WMGA in the fall.
