## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

**Due Wednesday, May 22, 2019**

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. An applicant must be a young woman who has exhibited an interest or association with the game of golf.
2. An applicant must establish financial need by submitting copies of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), SAR (Student Aid Report), her parent's and her personal income tax returns, and financial aid decisions.
3. An applicant must have applied to or attend a university, college or accredited trade school.
4. An applicant must demonstrate scholastic ability by submitting SAT and/or ACT scores and high school and/or college transcripts.
5. An applicant must be of outstanding character, integrity and leadership.
6. An applicant must reside in the area covered by the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association. That area is within a 60 mile radius of Columbus Circle in NYC and the entirety of Long Island.
7. An applicant must be available for a personal interview with a member of the Foundation Board.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill out this application form and return it to the WMGA Foundation, 49 Knollwood Road, Elmsford, NY 10523, **no later than Wednesday, May 22nd**. You will receive a letter from the Foundation confirming receipt of your application.
2. Attach the following supporting documents to this application form:
  - a. High School transcript.
  - b. SAT and/or ACT scores.
  - c. College or trade school transcript (if applicable).
  - d. Copy of FAFSA filed with the Federal Student Aid Programs \*
  - e. Copy of SAR – result of FAFSA with EFC number.
  - f. Copy of the first page of applicant's and her family's most recent Federal Income Tax Return
  - g. Copy of financial aid decisions – i.e., grants, loans, work study, etc. (as soon as you receive them.)

\* Please file the FAFSA as soon as you can after January 1. Once processed, you will receive the SAR in six weeks. The FAFSA may be obtained from high school guidance office, college financial aid office, website [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), or call 800-4 FED AID.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The due date for all applications is May 22nd. If the application is not received at the WMGA Foundation office by May 22nd, it cannot be considered, but may be resubmitted for consideration in the following year. Applications are reviewed in May and June, and scholarships are awarded in July.

Each scholarship is applicable to tuition, room and board, incidental fees, and books. The scholarship is awarded for a specified number of semesters that is determined by the WMGA Foundation selection committee. The scholarship is subject to the student's continuation in school and to the continuation of the student's financial need. If a recipient does not enter school within one year of receiving an award, or leaves school at any time thereafter, any scholarship award may be canceled and the applicant may need to reapply for further assistance. Scholarship awards are made payable to the student; however, the student's academic verification and school transcript must be submitted in a timely manner to the Foundation

each semester or the applicant will forfeit the award. Any scholarship payments not used in a manner consistent with the terms of the scholarship award are to be returned to the Foundation. All information received by the Foundation will be kept confidential.

## 2019 Junior Girls' Fellowship Program

The Women's Metropolitan Golf Association Foundation is proud to announce our Junior Girls' Fellowship Program. An applicant has the opportunity to apply for the WMGA Fellowship which would afford a player all the playing privileges and responsibilities of a regular WMGA junior member. The recipient would be able to join the association for a one-year period with the opportunity to receive the honor again. The Association conducts about 30 competitions each year, providing WMGA members with one of the largest and most varied playing schedules in the Met area. The schedule includes individual, partner, family, and team tournaments.

To apply for the 2019 Junior Girls' Fellowship Program, please fill out the application, **including the attached brief description of why you should be selected** and forward it to our office no later than **Friday, May 3rd**. The selection of this year's Fellowship recipients will be handled by the WMGA Fellowship Committee consisting of WMGA Foundation board members; the WMGA Executive Director; an LPGA/PGA Professional; the Met PGA JGA Director; and a First Tee executive.

To be eligible a girl must meet the following criteria:

- She must be between 12-18 years of age (must not have reached her 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1/1/2019 and not started college).
- She must have a handicap index of 14.0 or less.
- She or her parents may not be a member of one of our member clubs.
- She must reside in the WMGA district (60 miles from Columbus Circle including all of Long Island).

The WMGA Fellowship Committee will select the 2019 recipients. The decision of the Committee is final. All girls selected will receive a formal invitation and a Mentor from our WMGA membership will be assigned to each girl for guidance.
