

Mrs. Hart's Team Captures Rain-Curtailed Golf Tourney

GREENWICH, Conn., May 13 —Mrs. A. S. Hart of Baltusrol and Mrs. DeWitt Alexandre of Somerset Hills won a curtailed Women's Metropolitan Golf Association better ball of partners tournament today.

Because of the rain that made the 6,084-yard, par-74 Round Hill course unplayable, the tournament committee had

to cancel the second round of this 36-hole event.

Mrs. Hart and Mrs. Alexandre, who scored a one-over-par 39, 36-75 yesterday, were declared the winners.

Mrs. Henry Cross, the tournament chairman of the W.M.G.A. this year, was two strokes behind with Mrs. Wilson Elmore, her Essex County clubmate, as her partner. They finished in a tie at 77 with Mrs. E. C. K. Finch of New Canaan and Maureen Orcutt of White Beeches.
