MRS. THORNE'S 83 TAKES GOLF MEDAL

Champion Leads 61 Rivals in Women's Westchester-Fairfield Qualifying Round.

SCORES EAGLE 2 ON 15TH

Mrs. Whalen Next With 87—
Mrs. Holman, Mrs. Luckey
Get 91s at Wee Burn.

NOROTON, Conn., June 15.—Striking the first blow in defense of the laurels she gained last year, Mrs. Jonathan Thorne of Innis Arden led a field of sixty-two in the qualifying round of the fourteenth annual women's Westchester-Fairfield golf championship at the Wee Burn Club today.

In taking medalist honors for the second successive time, the long-hitting Mrs. Thorne traversed the water-logged course in 42, 41-83, a brilliant eagle 2 on the fifteenth hole featuring her round. Even this magnificent effort left Mrs. Thorne four strokes short of women's par, but she did succeed in bettering her 1935 total at Apawamis by a stroke.

Four Strokes Behind Leader

Four strokes behind the leader came Mrs. Emmet Whalen of Westchester Hills, who posted 43, 44-87 despite a disastrous 7 on the par 4 ninth hole. Bracketed in third position were Mrs. Russell Holman, also of Innis Arden, with 44, 47-91 and Mrs. C. P. Luckey of Mount Kisco with 46, 45-91.

Experiencing an off day, Mrs. Henry H. Dietrich of Briar Hills, women's metropolitan champion, tied with Mrs. Thomas Hucknall of Woodway for fifth. The former Betty Pietsch, runner-up in this tournament in 1934, a semi-finalist last year and winner of the 1935 fifty-four hole medal play open event, carded 45, 47-92. Mrs. Hucknall shot 46, 46-92.

Course Made Heavy by Rain

The condition of the course, made heavy by the week-end rains, was largely responsible for the high scores. Only three other players succeeded in doing 95 or better.

Match play will open tomorrow and continue through Friday.
