

GOLF PRIZE IS WON BY MRS. FEDERMAN

Glen Oaks Star Shoots an 80
to Take Gross Laurels at
North Hempstead Club.

1.—Mrs. Leo G. Federman of Glen Oaks shot a splendid 80 to carry away the low gross award in the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's weekly tournament over the North Hempstead Country Club's links today. Fifty of the sixty-two players who teed off turned in cards.

The low net prize went to Mrs. George Viebrock of Queens Valley, whose score was 82-12-70. Mrs. Viebrock was tied with Mrs. Lennie Herman of Lakeville, who returned a card of 94-24-70, but won after matching cards.

The second best gross score of the day was accounted for by Mrs. Viebrock, who put a 40 and a 42 together for her 82. Mrs. Henry March of North Shore also played well, scoring 41-44-85.

Mrs. A. W. Rodney of Quaker Ridge won the putting prize with a total of 36.
