

NEW YORK GIRLS TRIUMPH IN GOLF

Miss Paine's 77 Helps Beat
Boston and Philadelphia

DEDHAM, Mass., July 2—

After a lapse of four years, New York won the junior intercity golf team matches at the Dedham Country and Polo Club today.

Led by the metropolitan and New Jersey junior champion, Sandy Paine of Rock Spring, New York defeated Philadelphia, 12½ to 2½, and Boston, 8½ to 6½. This gave New York 21 points.

Boston, the winner for the last four years, placed second with 16 points and Philadelphia was third with 8.

Miss Paine carded a 77 on the 5,607-yard, par-71 course and took 3 points from Laurie Herbicek of Philadelphia.

In her match with Lesley Milliken of Boston, Sandy had a battle before breaking even. Each got 1½ points. This gave the metropolitan junior champion 4½ points.

Lesley took 3 from the Philadelphia champion as she scored second low gross with a 70.

Playing at No. 2, Barbara Frelinghuysen added to the New York tally with 2 points from Meg Davis of Philadelphia and 2½ from Elaine Moulison of Boston.

Charity Benz, at No. 3, almost got her full total of 6 points in this Nassau system of scoring a point for the first nine, a point for the second nine and a point for the match.

Miss Benz, winner of the Tamarack Country Club women's championship, took 5½ points. She won 3 from Ann Dickey of Philadelphia and 2½ from Cathy Igoe of Boston.

The matches will be held in New York next year and New York will have all but Miss Frelinghuysen to defend the cup.

This is the 17-year-old Miss Igoe's last year as a golfing champion. She expects to enter St. Joseph's Convent, Framingham, Mass. in September.
