

GOLF LAURELS WON BY MISS GOTTLIEB

Ties Miss Warner, Mrs. Rodney
at 84, but Scores by Matching
Cards at Bonnie Briar.

MRS. PETERSON A VICTOR

Returns a Net Card of 70; With Mrs.
Bernard Two Strokes Higher
in One-Day Tourney.

LARCHMONT, N. Y., Aug. 30.—

Miss Bea Gottlieb, member of the Lakeville Club and runner-up in the metropolitan championship this year, won the low gross prize in the one-day tournament of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association at the Bonnie Briar Club today, but only after a card-matching process.

At the conclusion of the competition in which one of the largest fields of the season participated, Miss Gottlieb, Miss Alice Warner of the Greenwich Country Club and Mrs. A. W. Rodney of Quaker Ridge were tied for the prize, all making scores of 84.

Deciding the winner by matching cards for the round, Miss Gottlieb won, her margin over Miss Warner being 2 up and she was 1 up on Mrs. Rodney. By the same process, Mrs. Rodney was 1 up on Miss Warner.

Mrs. E. C. Peterson of the North Hempstead club on Long Island won the first low net with a score of 87. Her handicap was 17 and it gave her a low net score of 70.

Mrs. A. Bernard of the Tibbett's Brook club was second, two strokes behind, her gross score being 93 and her handicap 21.
