

Miss Gottlieb's 174 Qualifies Her in British Title Golf Play

Only American Entry Gains First Match Round; Miss Park Takes Medal at 153

GLENEAGLES, Scotland, May 13 (AP). —Miss Beatrice Gottlieb, of Mount Vernon, N. Y., lone American entry in the British women's golf championship, today scored an 84 for an eighteen-hole total of 174 to qualify among the sixty-four who will start match play tomorrow. No American woman ever has won the event.

Miss Doris Park, Scottish internationalist, led the qualifying field with a 153, scoring a 75 on her second round to set a new course record. Miss Wanda Morgan, with 158, was second. Miss Beryl Brown and Miss Enid Wilson, defending champion, were tied for third with 160.

Other scores were: Miss Elsie Corlett, 165, and Miss Diana Fishwick, former titleholder, 166.
