Lakeville Star Leads Field of
70 in One-Day Tourney at
Englewood G. C.

MISS ORCUTT HAS AN 83

Makes Her Debut Since Winning
Medal in British Title Play—
Mrs. Rudnick Takes Low Net.

ENGLEWOOD, N. J., June 28.—
Miss Bea Gottlieb of Lakeville, who
was runner-up in the women's met-
ropolitan championship last month,
led a field of seventy starters to win
low gross prize in a one-day tourney
of the Women's Metropolitan Golf
Association at the Englewood Golf
Club today. Her score was 42, 40—82.

Miss Maureen Orcutt, former dis-
trict champion, making her first met-
ropolitan appearance in competition
since her return from England, where
she was medalist last month in the
British championship, came home in
38 after taking 45 to the turn, her
total of 83 putting her one stroke too
high for the gross prize.

Mrs. George Rudnick of Tibbets
Brook, with 84—10—74, and Mrs. M.
Herman of Broadmoor, 95—20—75,
won the net prizes.
