in Women's Metropolitan Title Golf Event*

# VICTOR LAST YEAR CARDS 40, 39-79

**Mrs. Berger, Former Roslyn  
Swift, Wins Medal—Judy  
Frank Second With 82**

INWOOD, L. I., June 14—Mrs. Maxon Berger of Glen Oaks, the former Roslyn (Cookie) Swift, was invited by the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association to defend the metropolitan title she had won last year. Thus, Mrs. Berger, who was married last March and moved to Buffalo, was eligible to play in the fifty-first annual championship.

Today, over the Inwood Country Club course, Mrs. Berger started defense of her title by capturing the qualifying medal. Playing excellently around the greens, she had 40, 39—79 to defeat her nearest competitor by three strokes.

A field of seventy-seven contestants that included five former champions played under difficult conditions. This morning the course was covered with a heavy mist, making the course wet, and the golf balls became embedded many times.

Judy Frank of Aldecress, 19 years old, was in second place with 42, 40—82. Miss Frank, a junior at Barnard College, won the metropolitan junior championship last year.

#### Miss Mackie Gets 83

Six contestants turned in scores of 83. Among them was a home club player and 1951 metropolitan champion, Peggy Mackie. She had trouble with her woods, pushing many shots and putting badly. Her score was 44, 39.

The others in this bracket were Mrs. Philip Cudone of Montclair, New Jersey Association champion, who was steady with nines of 42, 41, Mrs. William Tracy of Essex Fells, runner-up last year; Mrs. Allan Ryan of the Creek; Mrs. Sophie Untermeyer of Century, and another home club contestant, Mrs. Bernard Freeman.

Mrs. Untermeyer was the only one in this group who played the first nine well, scoring a one-over-par 40. She finished with a 43.

## Mrs. Ryan Back in 38

Mrs. Tracy, Mrs. Ryan and Mrs. Freeman had trouble with the three par-5 holes in a row, starting with the third. Mrs. Ryan, former Eastern champion, had a 45 on the first nine, but came back well in a par 38.

Mrs. Marge Mason of Ridgewood, the 1952 Metropolitan champion, seemed headed for the medal when she toured the first nine in a one-under-par 38, but she faltered badly on the second nine. Starting on the eleventh hole, Mrs. Mason did not have a par on her card and soared to 47 for an 85.
