

MRS. MASON RETAINS JERSEY LINKS CROWN

SUMMIT, N. J., July 12—Mrs. Marge Mason of Ridgewood retained her Women's New Jersey Golf Association fifty-four hole medal play championship today with a 232 total at the Canoe Brook Country Club.

Mrs. Mason, who took a four-stroke lead over Mrs. Philip Cudone of Montclair in today's final round, lost her advantage on the first nine, but regained two strokes coming in.

Mrs. Mason finished with a 43, 37—80. Mrs. Cudone fired a 39, 39—78 for a 234 total.

Mrs. Mason picked up two strokes on the twelfth, where Mrs. Cudone was trapped, and increased the margin to four on the sixteenth.

Mrs. Cudone, seeking her sixth New Jersey crown, finished with a par on the seventeenth and a birdie on the eighteenth to cut the margin to two shots.
