

32nd Shore Championship Won by Mrs. Pat Cici

Shore batting average: 1000 – Mrs. Pat Cici, Cedar Brook, entered the WMGA New Jersey Shore Tournament twice and has won it twice. Who could do better than that? Her 54-hole total of 236 was six strokes ahead of the runner-up, Mrs. A. Sherburne Hart, Essex County. But for the second year in a row the first day leader was Miss Charlotte DeCozen, Westchester, who scored 41-39-80 (first daily gross). Last year's winner, Mrs. William Tracy, Essex Falls, carded 42-39-81, the same nines as Mrs. Hart. They were tied at 81 with Mrs. Cici, 45-36-81; and Mrs. Alexander Munro, Innis Arden, 41-40-81. Deadlocked at 83 were Mrs. DeWitt Alexandre, Somerset Hills, 43-40-83; Mrs. E. C. K. Finch, New Canaan, 44-39-83 (second daily gross); Mrs. Oliver Vietor, Rumson, 42-41-83; Mrs. Irving Kaufmann, Century, 41-42-83; and Mrs. Thomas McDarby, Deal, 43-40-83. Scores of 84 over the Rumson course were posted by Mrs. Henry Doubilet, Hollywood, 43-41-84; Miss Kathy Linney, Plainfield, 40-44-84; Mrs. Melvin Fields, Harbor Hill, 43-41-84; Miss Maryann Hagen, High Ridge, 43-41-84; and Mrs. Norman Kelley, Somerset Hills, 42-42-84; and Miss Gwen Pallante, Cedar Brook, 46-38-84. Mrs. Edward Katz, Greenacres, won first low net for the day with a 74 in a sudden death match of cards with Mrs. J. Jarema, Metuchen, second net, and Mrs. E. Turner, Hollywood, third net.

Mrs. Cici moved into the number one position by scoring a fine 38-40-78 on the Deal Golf Club course for a 159 total. Sharing second spot were Mrs. Finch with 83-79-162 and Mrs. Hart with a consistent 81-81-162. Miss DeCozen added an 83 to her 80 for a 163 while Mrs. Victor had the reverse, 83-80-163. Following the leaders after two rounds were Mrs. Alexandre, 164; Mrs. McDarby, 165; Mrs. Kaufmann, 166; Mrs. Munro, 167; Miss Linney, 168, and Mrs. Tracy, 169. First low gross for the day went to Mrs. McDarby with 82 and second low gross to Mrs. Kaufmann, 83. The first daily net at Deal was won by Mrs. C. Corwin, Fenway, 74; and Mrs. James Dormont, Montclair, was awarded second low net for her 75.

Playing consistently good golf, Mrs. Cici finished with a 37-40-77 and a 236 total to win the 32nd Shore Championship. Mrs. Cici had won this tournament previously in 1959. The runner-up was Mrs. Hart, a golfer for only six years, who had 81-81-80-242. Third low gross went to Mrs. Munro with 81-86-82-249. The results of a sudden death match of cards were fourth gross to Mrs. Tracy, 81-88-81-250 and fifth gross to Mrs. Victor, 83-80-87-250. The Charles A. Stillman memorial plate for first low net for the 54 holes went to Mrs. Alexandre with 250-30-220. Second low net was won by Mrs. William Sullivan, Deal, 259-33-226. Mrs. A. Anthony Dreyspool, Fairview, was the winner on the draw of third low net with 256-27-229; and Mrs. Finch was fourth with 250-21-229. Fifth net was won by Mrs. H. H. Staehling, Rock Spring, 261-30-231. The daily gross at Hollywood went to Miss Pallante, 81 – first; and to Mrs. Kelley, 83 – second. First low net for the final day went to Mrs. Fields, 74; and second low net to Mrs. Charles Lewis, Deal, 75.
