

Dempsey Gives Gals Golf Lesson

Mrs. Thorne Dempsey, 1969 Met champion, yesterday annexed low gross prize in the Women's LIGA medal competition at North Hempstead CC, Port Washington.

Mrs. Dempsey clipped par by a stroke on the front nine with 35, then finished in 40, two under regulation figures. Second gross award went to Mrs. F.K. Thayer of Piping Rock, who posted 43-40-83. Carol Beinbrink, also of Piping Rock, was tied at 84 with Mrs. Geoffrey Steinemann of Nassau CC. The latter, who covered the inward nine in 40, won low net with 71. Mrs. Jack Gall of the host club was

second net at 86-14-72.

Mrs. Vincent Larkin and Mrs. Karl Clement, both of Nassau CC, were deadlocked for fifth at 85, Mrs. Charles Cullen of Hempstead G&CC had 88 and Peggie Mackie of Inwood CC, a former Met titleholder, posted 90.
