

# Gail Flanagan Captures Maureen Orcutt Tourney

**HAWORTH, N.J., July 12** — Gail Flanagan of the Westchester Country Club won the 19th Maureen Orcutt tournament for junior girls today when she posted a 76 on the 5,756 yard par-74 White Beeches Country Club course.

The 17-year-old Miss Flanagan prevailed by six shots over Mary Cabriele, also of Westchester. The tournament is named for the former golf writer for The New York Times, who now is retired in Durham, N.C.

Other gross leaders were Pamela Darmstadt of Winged Foot, 83; Kendra Beard of Essex Fells, 84, and Patty Famula of Galloping Hill, 87.

Low net went to Mary Ellen Famula of Galloping Hill, who had 96, 30—66. Ellen Sexton of Manasquan was second at 101, 34—67.
