

MRS. TRACY'S 76 WINS GOLF PRIZE

77—Net Honors Taken by

Essex Fells won low-gross hon-
ors today in the opening one-
day tournament of the New
Jersey division of the Women's
Metropolitan Golf Association.

Scoring 35, 41—76 over the
5,949-yard par-74 Green Brook
Country Club course, Mrs.
Tracy led her nearest rival by
one stroke. Her score on the
first nine included birdies on the
fourth and sixth holes. She went
one over par on the ninth.

Mrs. Philip Cudone of Forest
Hill Field Club, the New Jersey
State champion, was second
with 37, 40—77.

Only one other player in the
field of sixty broke 80. That was
the metropolitan champion,
Maureen Orcutt of White
Beeches, who shot 39, 39—78.

Mrs. Frank Niering of Powel-
ton finished late in the day with
