

# Miss Mintz Wins Met. Junior Golf

PORT WASHINGTON, N. Y., Aug. 10 (P).—Eighteen-year-old Judy Mintz of Great Neck, L. I., captured the Metropolitan Junior girls golf title today for the second successive year. The Skidmore College freshman fired an 83 over the 6,310-yard North Hempstead Country Club course to win by six strokes.

Tied for second were Diana Williams, of Plainfield, N. J., eighteen-year-old Connecticut college student and sixteen-year-old Carol Ann Pflug of Hempstead, L. I., on a matching of cards, Miss Williams carried off second prize.

Pamela Eakins and Judy Coburn, both of Glen Cove, L. I., were tied at 102 with Mary Warwick, of Ridgewood, N. J., next at 105.

Miss Mintz, who will be eligible again next season, was six strokes over women's par at the turn with 42. Her 41 on the inward nine, including a birdie four at the final hole, was three shots over regulation figures. Judy's usually reliable putter turned traitor at the first, tenth, and sixteenth as she required three shots on the greens.
