Laddie and Whitehead Return 80½ in New Jersey Mixed Foursomes Tourney

MISS ORCUTT GAINS PRIZE

She and MacCallum Take Net Honors With 81½-2-79½ at Essex County Club

WEST ORANGE, N. J., June 20—Miss Laddie Irwin, New Jersey medal-play champion, and Charley Whitehead, holder of the State amateur golf title, today won the Women's New Jersey Golf Association's annual mixed foursome tournament at the Essex County Country Club with the odd score of 80½.

The total was determined by adding Laddie's gross score of 84 to Whitehead's 77 and dividing by two.

Miss Maureen Orcutt of Ridgewood, seven times metropolitan champion, teamed with Ian MacCallum, a former New Jersey amateur titleholder, and won the first net award with a score of 81½-2-79½.

Net scores were determined by subtracting three-eighths of the combined handicap from the gross.

Like Miss Irwin, Miss Orcutt carded an 84. MacCallum's 79 was second to Whitehead's 77 in individual scoring.

Two additional net awards were captured by Mrs. James Patton of Suburban and E. M. Wilson of Roselle, with 88½-7-81½, and by Mr. and Mrs. Harry Irwin of Upper Montclair, Laddie's parents, with a card of 95½-13-82½.
