

112 Women to Start in Quest Of Met. Golf Title Tomorrow

Mrs. Mason Aims To Retain Crown In 50th Tourney

The fiftieth Women's Metropolitan Golf Association championship starts tomorrow over the rolling acres of the Metropolis Country Club in White Plains, N. Y., and the Golden Jubilee tournament has attracted an advance entry of 112 players, believed to be a record field.

Mrs. Marge Mason of Ridgewood is the defending champion. At Upper Montclair a year ago, Mrs. Mason became the first New Jersey player to win the crown since Mrs. Laddie Irwin Homer succeeded Maureen Orcutt in 1947.

Miss Orcutt, also from Ridgewood, who has taken the Metropolitan title eight times, and the three champions who preceded Mrs. Mason, are back for another try to accentuate the stern opposition which is barring Mrs. Mason's way for a repeat triumph.

The quartet of former winners includes Mrs. Mortimer May, formerly of Willow Brook on Long Island, now of Englewood in the Jersey section, who was victorious in 1948; Mrs. Reinert M. Torgerson of Cherry Valley, L. I., triumphant in 1949 and 1950; and Margaret (Peggy) Mackie of Inwood, L. I., the 1951 champion.

Although an automatic qualifier, Mrs. Mason will play a practice round in tomorrow's preliminaries, paired with Miss Mackie.

The field will begin to shoot for the thirty-two championship flight berths at 8:30 a. m. and keep going off the first tee, in twosomes at four minute intervals. The possibility of post-entries exists, so that the group of contestants might well surpass 120.

Mrs. Gordon Park, of Glen Ridge, who captured the qualifying medal with a 75 in 1952, is again seeking the crown, as is Rosalind (Cookie) Swift, of Glen Oaks (L. I.), losing finalist last summer.

The strong New Jersey contingent includes Mrs. Philip Cudone, of Montclair, and Mrs. Joseph Frelinghausen jr., of Somerset Hills, both 1952 semi-finalists.

Westchester has strength in Mrs. Allison Choate, of The Apawamis Club, the reigning tri-county queen, and Mrs. Sophie Untermeyer, of Century, present holder of the Fairfield-Westchester Wheeler Cup and of the Jersey Shore championship. Possessor of many titles through the years, Mrs. Untermeyer has never succeeded to the Met throne, although twice a finalist—against both Mrs. Torgerson and Miss Mackie.

Match play in the title-flight will extend through to Saturday's thirty-six-hole final.
