

MISS DOCTOR'S 85 WINS JUNIOR GOLF

Paula Stott, 14, One Stroke
Back—Maria Gardella, 3d

LOCUST VALLEY, L. I., Aug. 7—Mary Ann Doctor of White Beeches won the thirty-eighth annual Women's Metropolitan Golf Association junior championship today.

In an exciting finish, the 17-year-old Miss Doctor had to play the last five holes in even par to retain the title she won last year. Her score over the 5,524-yard par-72 course at The Creek was 44, 41—85.

Paula Stott of the Nassau Country Club finished with a 44, 42—86. It was the third time in three weeks that 14-year-old Paula, the daughter of the former Long Island amateur champion, Gordon Stott, had broken 90.

Fifteen golfers, all 17 or under, competed. Some of them were playing eighteen holes for the first time. There were also five Nassau Country Club youngsters who played only nine holes. The winner of the nine-hole competition was Kim Hudson with 54—16—38.

In the championship round, 16-year-old Maria Gardella of Jumping Brook began with nine straight 5's. She came home in 43 for an 88 that was good for third place.

Nancy Albert of Green Acres, who recently won the Trenton Women's Golf Association championship, was even with Miss Doctor on the first nine when she scored 44. However a three-over-par 8 on the thirteenth hole and two 6's brought Nancy's score to 47 for the second nine. She was fourth with a 91.

Miss Doctor had trouble on the third hole. After hitting a fine drive, she hooked her second shot into the rough about hole high. Her chip to the green was short and landed in a trap. From there she went over the green into another trap. She finally ended up with a four-over-par 8.

Miss Doctor lost three more strokes to par when she took a 7 on the sixth hole. A two-over and par came on the short eleventh was followed by a out-of-bounds ball on the thirteenth.

Another youngster playing in this event for the first time, 15-year-old Barbara Frelinghuysen of Somerset Hills, shared low net honors with Paula Stott of Nassau. Miss Frelinghuysen posted a 100—29—71, Miss Stott an 86—15—71.
