

MISS DOCTOR'S 80 WINS ORCUTT GOLF

White Beeches Star Beats Nancy Albert by 6 Shots

Mary Ann Doctor of White Beeches won the second annual Maureen Orcutt tournament over her home course today. She also won last year.

Despite a heavy course because of an all-night rain, Miss Doctor won by six strokes with a 43, 37—80. Nancy Albert of Greenacres finished second for the second year in a row.

Nancy played well through the fairways, but she three-putted five greens.

Mary Ann, playing with a new set of clubs, had trouble on the fairways over the first nine holes. However, she found the range on the incoming nine.

This was the last junior tournament for Mary Ann and Nancy. They will be 18 years old on their next birthdays.

Low-net honors went to 15-year-old Barbara Frelinghuysen of Somerset Hills with 105—26—79. Neither Mary Ann nor Nancy could take home two prizes.

Linda MacDonald of Essex Fells, also playing her last junior tournament, was next with 106—25—81.
