

WMGA squad

wins Griscom Cup

NEWTOWN SQUARE, Pa. — The seven-member team from the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association which included New Jerseyan Ann Probert of Baltusrol won the 79th Griscom Cup Intercity Team Championship yesterday at the Aronomink Golf Club.

The WMGA compiled a total of 24½ points during the two days of matches over the 5,867-yard course and defeated the Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia by one point. The WGA of Massachusetts finished with 15 points.

The WMGA team, which snapped a three-year winning streak by Philadelphia, had also won the cup in 1981, 1982 and 1983. The event was rained out last year.

Also competing for the WMGA were New Yorkers Margaret Platt of Knollwood, Karen Gray of Pelham, Judy Cooperstein of North Shore and Sara Sage of Piping Rock and Connecticut's Hatsy Hart of Silver Spring and Barbara Young of Aspetuck Valley.
