Y., May 28.— Mrs. Jonathan Thorne, the former Polly Andrews, newly crowned women's metropolitan golf champion, scored a brilliant 38 on the homeward nine for a total of 81 and the low gross prize in the Westchester-Fairfield weekly tournament over the Siwanoy Country Club course today.

Mrs. Thorne started slowly, taking 43 to the turn, but showing true championship style, she began the trip in with an eagle 3 on the long tenth, and thereafter got 2 birdies and 3 par holes to finish one under women's par for the

Mrs. Frank A. Van Ness of Siwanoy tied for low net with Mrs. William Callan, St. Andrews Club, but won on card matching, 97—17—80. Mrs. William H. Pomeroy, Winged Foot, also tied Mrs. Albert J. Brosseau of Blind Brook for the third place and won on matching, 106—25—81. Mrs. John Morton, Siwanoy, won the putting with 30 on the greens.

Two 6s on the second and fourth holes, and a bunkered drive for a 4 on the short sixth carried Mrs. Thorne's score 3 over par going out, but from the turn the deadliness of her iron shots and the allaround chosistency of her play were most impressive.

The tenth and the sixteenth holes saw Mrs. Thorne's most spectacular examples of control and recovery. On the tenth green in 2, she dropped a twenty-foot putt for an eagle 3.

Miss Betty Pietsch, runnerup in the metropolitan championship last week, missed a chance for considerably lower score by hard luck on the greens. She had a total of 85.
