

# MISS KNAPP TAKES LOW GROSS IN GOLF

Ties Miss Robinson With 87,  
Then Triumphs by Matching  
Cards in One-Day Event.

## PLAYERS DEFY WEATHER

Low Net Award Goes to Miss  
Robinson, Who Scores 75 on  
Women's National Links.

GLEN HEAD, L. I., Aug. 22.—

A field of nearly forty intrepid linkswomen braved the threatening weather today to participate in the one-day tournament held on the Women's National Golf and Tennis Club course under the auspices of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association.

Rain-sodden fairways made the going difficult, and as a result a pair of 87s, ten above women's par, tied for the low gross honors. Miss Rosalie Knapp, the club champion, had one of them, and Miss Isabella Robinson of Salisbury the other.

First award was determined by matching cards for the full eighteen holes, and Miss Knapp won by the narrow margin of 1 up.

Miss Robinson received first low net with a 75, and Mrs. C. J. Carbone, another Salisbury representative, second low net with a 76.

Miss Knapp had only two par

holes on the first nine and two birdies and a par on the second, her out and in scores being 43 and 44.

Miss Robinson had three pars and one birdie going out and three pars and a birdie coming home.

# Matched Card Decides Prize For Miss Knapp

## Miss Robinson Ties Winner of Low Gross in One-Day Golf at Women's National

GLEN HEAD, L. I., Aug. 22.—By matching cards, Miss Rosalie Knapp, of the home club, won the low gross prize from Miss Isabel Robinson, of Salisbury, in a women's metropolitan one-day golf event held over the Women's National Golf and Tennis Club course today.

Both Miss Knapp and Miss Robinson, early starters, who played through a heavy drizzle and over a water-soaked course, carded 43—44—87. Although beaten for the gross prize, Miss Robinson, with a twelve handicap, won the low net award with a 75, one stroke ahead of Mrs. S. J. Carbone, of Salisbury, with a 76.

A field of thirty-seven left the first tee, but only twenty-two finished with cards.
