MRS. UNTERMAYER TAKES GOLF MEDAL

Scores 78 in Tri-County Test for 3-Stroke Margin Over Mrs. Bartol at Rye

RYE, N. Y., Aug. 11—For the second year in a row Mrs. Sophie Untermeyer of Century won the medal in the Women's Tri-County Golf Association championship with a 5 over par 39, 39—78 over the Apawamis Club course today. Mrs. Untermeyer, who thus retains the Kay Byrne memorial candelabra that goes to the medalist, was the only player in the field of forty-nine able to break 80.

The Century champion, who won the Elizabeth Wheeler Trophy and the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association Shore tournament, had a three-stroke margin.

Second was Mrs. John H. Bartol of Greenwich, with 41, 40—81. Mrs. Bartol's score was marred by a 2 over par 7 on the 549-yard ninth hole and two bogies on the last two holes.

Mrs. Greer Cards 82

Mrs. Clarence Greer of Fairview was third with 37, 45—82. Mrs. Greer hasn't played much tournament golf and only last week had a cast removed from her knee, but her one-over-par 37 on the first nine was the best of the day. On the inward nine a streak of poor putting and bad chip shots sent Mrs. Greer over par and brought her home in 45.

This tournament, which is open to only those players with handicaps of 12 and under, has three former champions in the field. The defending champion, Barbara Bruning of Whipoorwill, who had been ordered by her doctor to take a complete rest from tournament golf, decided to compete nevertheless. She was exempt from qualifying.

The winner of the title in 1949, Mrs. T. Arthur Menzel of Innis Arden, placed fourth with 41, 42—83. Mrs. Allison Choate of the home club and holder of the course record, a 71, posted an 84. Mrs. Jerome Herbert of Old Oaks, last year's finalist, shot an 85, and Mrs. Donald O'Brien of Winged Foot, the 1950 champion, turned in an 86.

Others who found the course difficult because of the recent rains were Mrs. Charles Spalding of Round Hill, who carded 86, and Mrs. Sally Francis of Wykagyl, who qualified with 88.

Mrs. Adrian Easton of Quaker Ridge won the last place in the championship flight in a three-way play-off at 91. At the third extra hole the Quaker Ridge player sank a 40-foot putt for a par 4 and the victory.

Match play will start tomorrow, with two rounds scheduled for Wednesday and the final at 36 holes on Friday.
