Take Husband-Wife Laurels
by 3 Strokes Over Lymans,
Who Gain Net Award

WEST CALDWELL, N. J., July 24—Mr. and Mrs. William Tracy of Glen Ridge won the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association husband-and-wife championship at Mountain Ridge today.

Playing alternate shots and putting well, Mr. and Mrs. Tracy turned in a four-over-par 39, 37—76, to lead a field of seventy-two teams and gain the new Jane Robbins Memorial silver tray. The old trophy, a bronze figure of a woman golfer, will be given to Golf House for its trophy room.

In second place were Mr. and Mrs. Theron V. Lyman of Maplewood. The Lymans had the same score on the first nine as the champions, but couldn't keep the pace on the homeward journey as they carded a 79.

There was a tie for the first low net award between three teams.

On the luck of the draw the Lymans were the winner with a tally of 79—5—74.
