

# Misses Pietsch And Singer Win At Tamarack

**Mrs. Thomson, Mrs. Stevens  
Extend Medalists; Misses  
Silleck, Snyder Advance**

PORT CHESTER, N. Y., June 22.—

Miss Catherine Singer and Miss Betty Pietsch, co-medalists in the Women's Westchester-Fairfield golf championships, reached the semi-final round at the Tamarack Country Club here today, but only after the strongest opposition. Miss Pietsch had to go twenty holes to defeat Mrs. J. J. Thomson, of Siwanoy, and Miss Singer won, 2 up, from Mrs. Edwin Stevens, of Round Hill.

Miss Helen Silleck, of Greenwich, and Miss Frances Snyder, of Apawamis, also reached the semi-final round. Miss Silleck, last year's medalist, defeated Mrs. George M. Hite jr., of Apawamis, 4 and 3, and Miss Snyder put out Mrs. John Lapham, of Woodway, 3 and 2.

Miss Thomson led Miss Pietsch by three holes going to the eleventh. Each had 88 for eighteen holes.

Miss Pietsch won the eleventh and then the fifteen when she sank a thirty-foot putt for a deuce on a 133-yard par 3 hole. She evened the count on the seventeenth with a par 5 to Mrs. Thomson's 7.

Miss Singer was held even by Mrs. Stevens until the sixteenth, when the latter drove out of bounds.

In the semi-finals tomorrow Miss Singer will meet Miss Silleck and Miss Pietsch will play Miss Snyder.
