Betty Pietsch Wins Women's Met. Golf Play

Tamarack Star Scores 80 for Low Gross Honors; Mrs. Whalen Is Low Net

WHITE PLAINS, N. Y., Aug. 28.—While intermittent rains served to hamper play somewhat in the one-day golf tourney of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association at the Westchester Hills Club here today, it did not seem to dampen the golfing ability of Miss Betty Pietsch, of the Tamarack Country Club, as she came home in front of the field to win the low gross prize.

Her gross score of 80 was better by several strokes than that of her nearest competitor and with her handicap she tallied a 78 for the round. The dampened greens and fairways did not seem to bother Miss Pietsch, as she shot them down the fairways and pitched them with accuracy to the pin hole after hole.

Mrs. Emmett Whalen, of the home club, and its leading scorer, carried off first low net prize with her 82—5—77. She was Miss Pietsch's nearest competitor for low gross. Mrs. R. J. Quinn, of the Rye Country Club, took second low net with 102—24—78.
