

Miss Pietsch, With 84, Annexes Metropolitan Qualifying Honors

Lawrence Farms Golfer Leads Ninety Rivals as Championship
Tourney Opens at Apawamis—Miss Fisher Gets 86 and
Mrs. Lake 87—Mrs. Federman's 88 Ties Miss Adel.

RYE, N. Y., May 20.—The qualifying honors in the women's metropolitan golf championship went to a 22-year-old Westchester golfer, Miss Betty Pietsch of the Lawrence Farms Club, Mount Kisco, as the tournament started at the historic Apawamis Club today.

While a number of the favorites for the title, won for the fifth time by Mrs. Maureen Orcutt Crews last year, were either missing from the competition or else encountering unusual golfing experiences, Miss Pietsch played steadily to card an 84.

The former municipal champion, Miss Marion Fisher of Oak Ridge, was in second place with an 86, while Mrs. Marion Turpie Lake of Plandome, erstwhile Southern and Long Island titleholder, turned in an 87, which included an 8 at the eleventh hole.

Mrs. Federman Cards 12.

Although an 8 is disheartening enough on qualifying day, Mrs. L. Federman of Lakeville, the New York State champion, managed to qualify well up among the leaders despite a 12 at the same hole. Established as one of the chief contenders for the title, following the withdrawal of Miss Charlotte Glutting, the New Jersey star, Mrs. Federman set out in encouraging style by holing the first nine in 39, exactly women's par.

After three putting the tenth for a 6, she pushed her tee shot at the 340-yard par 4 eleventh. That was the beginning of the trouble. She put her next drive on the fairway, but her approach struck a rock and toppled into a hole in a bunker guarding the green.

Finally extricating the ball from the hazard, Mrs. Federman sent it flying to a trap across the green. She played back again to the first bunker and eventually put the ball on the green on her tenth stroke, before taking two putts and holing out.

As damaging as this proved to Mrs. Federman's chances of win-

ning the medal, the New York State champion, evidently unnerved, went on to finish the round by playing the next seven holes in par for an 88. It was a grand finish and whereas many a golfer might have failed to qualify under similar circumstances, Mrs. Federman tied for fourth in the field of ninety-one starters.

Miss Ruth M. Adel of Queens Valley, the Long Island titleholder, with a 44 on each half, was bracketed with Mrs. Federman.

Shoots 44 on First Nine.

Miss Pietsch, who captured her first major golf award two seasons ago when she annexed the Westchester and Fairfield title, went out in 44, losing strokes to par at the fourth where she three-putted for a 6, the sixth where she was bunkered for a 5 and the long ninth where she sent her approach into a hazard and carded a 7.

Coming back, she topped an iron shot at the tenth that resulted in a 6 and although she overplayed the next, she had women's par or better the rest of the way for an incoming 40.
