

Jersey Shore Golf Lead Taken by Miss De Cozen

DEAL, N. J., Aug. 4.—With the champion, Mrs. Sophie Untermeyer, of Century, unable to compete because of her father's illness, the New Jersey Shore golf championship tournament of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association began at the Deal Golf and Country Club today.

The early leaders after the first eighteen holes of the fifty-four to be played were Essene DeCozen, of the Montclair Golf Club, with a low gross of 78 and Mrs. Joseph Connor, of the home club, with a low net of 95—20—75.

Miss DeCozen's round of 40—38 was three strokes better than the tour of Mrs. William Tracy, of Glen Ridge, former state champion and one of the star golfers in the metropolitan area. Mrs. Tracy was out in 41 and back in 40 for an 81, a score one

stroke better than that of Miss Betty Park, a fellow Glen Ridge member, who had a 40—42.

Second to Mrs. Connor among the net players was Mrs. Clarence E. Unterberg, of the Hollywood Golf Club, who posted an 88—12—76. Two other players were tied at 77—Mrs. Norman Glauber jr. (96—19—77) and Mrs. Leonard Block, of Hollywood, (91—14—77).

The tournament will continue tomorrow at the Rumson Country Club and will conclude the following day at Hollywood.
