

The Baldwins And DeCozens Sweep Golf

WATCHUNG, N. J., July 12—Brothers-in-law are brothers when it comes to the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association. That was the new rule applied to the twenty-first annual brother-sister tournament held at Twin Brooks today.

David Baldwin, of Baltusrol, last year's New Jersey State Open champion, became eligible May 17 when he married Essene DeCozen thus becoming a brother-in-law to Charlotte DeCozen, of Montclair Golf Club.

This marriage also served to make David's twin brother, Theodore, a brother-in-law to the new bride—and eligible for the tournament, too.

The genealogy is merely introduction to this: the Baldwins and the DeCozens swept all the honors available to them at today's tournament.

David Baldwin — a left-hander—and Miss DeCozen shot par golf on the way out and scored a 35—40—75 to win the big silver cup that goes to the champions. Mrs. David Baldwin and Ted Baldwin were just two strokes behind, 38—39—77. With half of the combined handicaps subtracted that left them with a net of 71—low for the day.

Par for the 6,410-yard course is 71. Women played the white markers which made their total distance some 200 yards less.
