

Mrs. Freeman-Mrs. Weinsier Lead in Scotch Foursomes Golf

Team Shoots a 76 for Stroke Edge at Leewood—Mrs. Kirkland's Duo Next

CRESTWOOD, N. Y., Sept. 4—Mrs. Bernard Freeman of Inwood and Mrs. Saul Weinsier of Fresh Meadow took a stroke lead in the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's John B. Mackie Memorial Scotch foursome golf tournament today.

Playing alternate drives and alternate shots over the hilly 6,017-yard, par-72 Leewood Country Club course, Mrs. Freeman and Mrs. Weinsier combined to score 38, 38—76. They won the event last year.

In second place were Mrs. William R. Kirkland Jr. of Piping Rock, former Long Island champion, and Mrs. Sophie Untermeyer of Century, the 1954 metropolitan champion, with 40, 37—77.

These were the only players in the field of forty-two teams to break 80. Tied at 80 were Mrs. Philip Cudone of Forest Hill Field Club and her partner, Mrs. Sally Francis of Apawamis, and the team of Mrs. Norman Woolworth of Winged Foot and Mrs. Charles Spalding of Round Hill. Both teams had nines of 40, 40.

The best outward nine of the day was the 2-over-par 37 by the Englewood duo of Mrs. Peter Pesci and La Junta White. However, on the homeward nine they had eight 5's and one 4
