

# SANDY PAINE TIES MISS LINNEY AT 82

## Two Girls Share Junior Golf Lead in Jersey

HAWORTH, N. J., Aug. 29—

For the second year in a row the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's fourth annual Maureen Orcutt medal-play tournament today ended in a tie.

Sandy Paine of Rock Spring, a 16-year-old Metropolitan and New Jersey junior champion, had a 40, 42—82, tying Kathy Linney, 17, of Plainfield, who posted a 43, 39—82 at the White Beaches Golf and Country Club. The playoff will be held Sept. 6.

This tournament, which is a part of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's program for juniors, had 14 contestants.

Cibby Benz, the ladies' club champion at Tamarack, was third with a 42, 44—86.

Cindy Bushart of Powelton, a recent winner of her club championship, was fourth with 47, 43—90.

Laurie Cohen of Cedar Brook, 14, won the first low net with a 96—22—74. Ann Rogers, of Canoe Brook was the runner-up with 98—23—75.

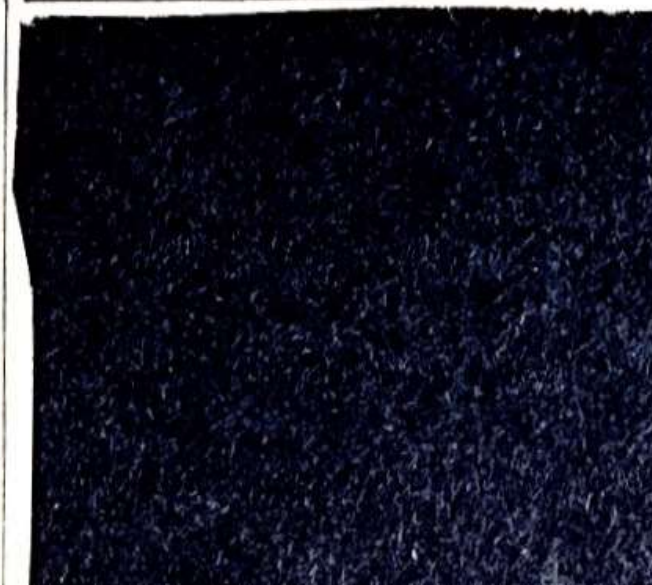
**Defending Champion And Kathy Linney  
In Playoff For Title Next Friday**

**Haworth**—Two attractive 17-year-old girls will square off next Friday in an 18-hole playoff for the Maureen Orcutt Trophy after tying with 82s yesterday at White Beeches Golf and Country Club in the Metropolitan Junior Girls' golf championship.

For Sandy Paine of Rock Spring, the experience is not a new one. Miss Paine was tied by Zonnie Tracy of Essex Fells a year ago and won a convincing victory in the playoff.

But for Kathy Linney of Plainfield, it will be quite a test. Miss Linney has been golfing only 4 years and has pulled her handicap down steadily. Although she was not a contestant last year, Miss Linney, who will enter Marymount College next month, has improved to the point where she knocked two more strokes off her handicap last month and is now playing at nine.

#### EXCELLENT PUTTING

"My putting is what did it," Miss Linney said with a smile. "I scrambled all over the course but had so many 1-putt greens I was amazed." She finished with 28 putts, low in the tourney, but was ineligible for the putting prize since she will pick up either first or second gross.

Miss Paine, who in addition to defending this title recently successfully defended both her New Jersey Junior crown and the Women's Metropolitan Junior, is a senior at Beard School in Orange. Her stumbling block was the 16th hole where she 3-putted, taking four shots from the edge, for a double-bogey six.

Fifteen girls competed in the event, which was inaugurated in 1961 by Frank Licata as a tribute to Maureen Orcutt, long considered one of the finest woman amateur golfers in the game. Mary Ann Doctor won the initial event with Miss Paine gaining the only other crown last year.

Winner of the low net was Laurie Cohen of Cedar Brook, a 14-year-old who posted a fine 96-22-74. Second low net went



to Ann Rogers of Canoe Brook with 98-23-75, and third net to Cindy Bushart of Newburgh with 90-12-78. Putting honors were taken by Mary Ann Johnson of the host White Beeches club with 35.

The playoff will begin at 2 P.M. next Friday at White Beeches.
