PURCHASE, N. Y., Oct. 11—
Mrs. Joseph A. Nesbitt of the
Westchester Country Club won
the 17th annual Women's
Metropolitan Golf Association
senior championship today.

Mrs. Nesbitt had a bit of
trouble with high winds that
swept over the 6,960-yard, par-
74 Century Country Club
course. Playing the back nine
first, Mrs. Nesbitt had a nine-
over-par 46. The new champion
returned in 41 for an 87. This
added to her first round of 83,
gave her a 36-hole total of 170
and the Clara Rossin Trophy
on her first attempt.

There was a tie for second
place between Mrs. Vincent De
Paul Larkin of Nassau and
Maureen Orcutt of White
Beeches at 172. Mrs. Larkin had
a second 86 for her 172. Miss
Orcutt, a five-time winner of
this championship, had the best
round of the day, an 83. Her
first round score was 89.

Mrs. Doubilet Falters

Mrs. Henry Doubilet of Hollywood, in second place yesterday, scored an 89-hole total of 174 and fourth place.

A former champion, Mrs. Leon Weil of Inwood, and Mrs. F. C. Leffler of Meadow Brook were next at 175.

The Clara Rossin Trophy was donated by the late Mrs. Robert Ackerman of Century in honor of her mother. Today the women's Metropolitan Golf Association donated a trophy in memory of Mrs. Ackerman, who died last week while competing in the national senior championship to Atlantic City.

This trophy, for the low net for 36 holes, was won by Mrs. Leffler. Her net score was 175-22—153. Second low net went to Mrs. Daniel Waldner of Cold Spring Harbor for her score of 181-24—157, while Mrs. James Dorment of Montclair won third net for 182-24—158.
