Linney duo wins in mom-daughter

The duo scored a 43-45-88 over the 6,071-yard spread in the selected drive, alternate shot competition that matched 25 teams on a windy, sunny afternoon. The Linneys, whose victory was in doubt until the final putt, were followed closely by Mrs. John Frelinghuysen of Somerset Hills and her daughter, Mrs. Thomas Israel of Century, who had a 43-46-89.

Kathy, a four handicap, missed a four-foot putt on the 18th hole and admitted her mother carried the pair to the victory. It was not too long ago that she was teaching in Colorado and spending her

leisure time on the tennis courts.

Mrs. George and Miss Chris Kadel of Canoe Brook came in with a 47-51-98 but captured the net championship with a 73, figuring handicaps. Defending champs Mrs. William Tracy of Essex Fells and daughter Mrs. John Sheik, who have won the one-day event four times, were forced to withdraw because of illness in the family.
