

Women golfers finish last in field

GLADWYNE, Pa. — The Women's Metropolitan Golf Association entry in the Junior Girls Intercity Team Matches finished last in a field of three Wednesday behind Massachusetts and Philadelphia.

The Massachusetts team, selected from the greater Boston area, won with 16 points in the match play event. Philadelphia, which tied Massachusetts for the title last year,

scored 15 ½ points. WMGA had 13 ½.

The top-point scorer for WMGA was 17-year-old Liz Ward, of Bam Hollow CC, Lincroft, N.J. Ward copped three points apiece from her two opponents, the only WMGA player to record the perfect scoring feat. Paula Slivinsky, a 17-year-old from Salem Golf Club, picked up 1 ½ points, while Laura Algiero of Bonnie Briar CC, Larchmont, recorded 4 ½ points.
