

## ADRIENNE GILMARTIN 1982 JUNIOR CHAMPION

The Bedford Golf and Tennis Club was the site of our two-day stroke play championship held on July 27th and 28th. The first day was lovely and a field of twenty-two girls attacked the par 73, 5683 yard course. The low gross score for the day was an 82, shared by Debbie Lessel of Spook Hollow, Kathleen Doyle of Spring Brook, and Charlaine Tatz of Ashbrook. Our second day was almost rained out as the field started and then was called in when thunder and lightning occurred. After an hour's wait the rain stopped and all returned to the course to complete the round.

Adrienne Gilmartin was obviously not disturbed by the weather or interruption as she proceeded to post a par 73 for the day and combined with her first day's 84, a winning score of 157. Five strokes back was the runner-up, Karen Gray, who also posted fine scores of 83-79-162. All were truly awed by such a superior performance as was Adrienne's under such adverse circumstances. A real champion indeed who deserves our hearty congratulations!

Our low net trophy resulted in a tie for the second year in a row. This year, Karen Noble of Morris County and Susan Redard of Knickerbocker, tied at 144. In an 18-hole play-off held at Somerset Hills the following day, Karen Noble won with 103-27-76.

This year's gift to all the participants was a small tote bag, provided by the interest accrued from our Junior Fund, the principal of which was established by a gift from Mr. Thomas Pepitone three years ago.
