

Gilmartin streak at two; captures WMGA tourney

Adrienne Gilmartin of North Hempstead, N.Y., last week's winner of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's 36-hole Junior Girls' championship, yesterday made it two in a row with a triumph in the WMGA's Maureer Orcutt tournament at the White Beeches Golf and Country Club in Haworth.

Gilmartin, 16, who will be a senior at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, N.Y., this fall, shot a one-over-par 37-37-74 and finished five shots ahead of defending champion Karen Gray of Pelham, N.Y. Charlene Tatz of Ash Brook, daughter of professional Charles Tatz, was third after an 80.

Gilmartin, who will be competing in the U.S. Junior Girls' championship next week in Greeley, Colo., had three birdies against two bogeys and a double bogey on the 5,756-yard course.

Kerrie Wagner of Manasquan River won in the net division with a score of 94-27-67.
