

ADRIENNE GILMARTIN DEFENDS TITLE 1983 JUNIOR CHAMPION

Sands Point Golf Club was the site of our annual two-day stroke play championship on July 26 and July 27. The weather was just about perfect for both days and the par 72, 5,618-yard course proved a good test for the 12 participants. After the first round, Jean Bartholomew, Garden City, and Adrienne Gilmartin, North Hempstead, shared the lead as both shot rounds of 81, followed by Arle Presto who posted an 86.

On the second day, Jean and Adrienne again scored equal rounds, both shooting 84. After lunch, both girls went back out onto the course for an exciting 18-hole play-off. They both bettered their previous scores with identical rounds of 78. A sudden-death playoff ensued, and Adrienne won with a par 5 on the first hole as Jean took a bogey 6.

This was a tough loss for the 16-year old Jean who plays to a 4 handicap. She is a strong competitor and, undoubtedly, will be back next year vying for the trophy.
