

80 by Beards captures Mother-Daughter title

PURCHASE, N.Y. — New Jersey's Ann Beard and her daughter, Kendra, of the Essex Fells Country Club, combined shots for a 40-40-80 and won the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association Mother-Daughter championship yesterday at the Brae Burn Country Club.

Grace McGrath of Piping Rock and her daughter, Lisa Evans of Meadow Brook, placed second with a 40-42-

82 over the par-74, 5,938-yard course. The format was selective drive, alternate shot.

Ann Beard, who is the head of the United States Golf Association's Girls' Committee, and Kendra won the WMGA's Better-Ball Tournament five years ago.

Kendra, 21, winner of the Garden State Women's Round Robin tournament last year and the medalist in the WMGA Amateur qualifier this season, will be a senior at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, N.C., where she was the captain of the women's golf team this past season.

Julia and Anne Enstine of Southampton won the net division with a 71.
