

# Campbell edges

## Young on 19th

Derbie Campbell, a four-time club champion at the Canoe Brook Country Club in Summit, took advantage of local knowledge yesterday and advanced to today's quarterfinal round of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association's 82d Match-Play Championship at Canoe Brook.

Campbell, seeking her first victory in the championship, defeated Lee Berley of Edgewood, 3 and 1, in the first round in the morning and ended her match with Donna Young of Springdale on the 19th hole with a 15-foot par putt for a 1-up victory.

Also advancing to the quarterfinals were qualifying medalist Kendra Beard of Essex Fells, Ann Probert of Somerset Hills, New York's Yvonne Thiel of Whipoorwill, Sybil Whitman of Mountain Ridge, Kay Perrotty of Morris County, Gretchen Calvert of Morris County and Linda Schnoll of Shackamaxon.

Campbell took a 3-up lead over the first nine holes, highlighting her effort with a 25-foot putt at the third hole and a six-footer at the eighth for birdies and three-wood shot to within two feet of the pin at the 359-yard seventh hole, where she scored an eagle three.

Campbell, the 1983 Women's New

Jersey Golf Association Stroke-Play champion, gave it all back when she lost the 10th, 11th and 12th holes. She won the 13th with a par, lost the 15th to a birdie by Young and the two halved the next three holes to force the overtime.

"After you play over your head like I did," offered Campbell, "you suddenly realize you're playing well and you tend to lose your concentration."

On the first extra hole, the 333-yard, par-four first, Campbell missed the green but chipped to within 15 feet and sank the putt for a par against Young's bogey.

The 21-year-old Beard, who birdied three straight holes in the qualifying round on her way to a 78 Monday, defeated Kathleen Doyle of Spring Brook, 3 and 2, in the second round yesterday after scoring a 1-up victory over Evelyn Pyne of Somerset Hills in a first-round match that went the full 18 holes.

"I felt I was hitting the ball well," said Beard, who finished second last week in the Garden State Women's Stroke-Play Championship, "but I was having putting problems, particularly in the second round."

Doyle drew even by winning the 10th, but Beard won the 11th, 12th and 13th with pars. After losing the 14th, Beard won the 15th and halved the 16th to close out the match.

"After I won the 12th, I felt I had the momentum" said Beard. "Match play is difficult because anything can happen."

Two other second-round matches also went extra holes. Carole Besman of Woodlake sank a 20-foot birdie putt on the par-five 18th to pull even with Kay Perrotty of Morris County but lost to a bogey on the 19th hole. Perrotty will play Beard in the quarterfinals.

Gretchen Calvert's short putt for a par four on the 19th hole ended her match against Sue Lansdell of Ridgewood.

The semifinal round will be played tomorrow and the 36-hole final on Friday.
