

Former Rutgers golfer Maura Waters of Raritan Valley defeated former teammate Donna Young on the 20th hole of the semifinals of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association match play championship at Somerset Hills Country Club in Bernardsville yesterday.

Young birdied the 18th hole to send the match into sudden death. Both women parred on the 19th hole. Waters parred again on the 20th but Young bogied to send Waters into the finals against defending champion Karen Noble today at 8 a.m.

Noble, a 21-year-old senior from Wake Forest, was 1-over-par yesterday, defeating three-time Tri-County champ Reggie Hawes of Rye, N.Y., 3 and 2.

Young and Waters have faced each other before. Young defeated Waters in the first round of the New Jersey Amateur last year at Woodcrest in Cherry Hill, 2 and 1.
