

Waters jars Probert in WMGA play

Maura Waters of Raritan Valley, who set eight scoring records last year for the Rutgers women's team and recently won the Garden State Women's Golf Association Stroke-Play championship, ousted veteran standout Ann Probert of Somerset Hills on the 20th hole yesterday in the start of the Women's Metropolitan Golf Association Match-Play Championship at the Somerset Hills Country Club, in Bernardsville.

After defeating Probert, the 1985 match-play champion, Waters defeated LeeAnn Vogel of Southward Ho, Bayshore, N.Y., 3 and 2, in the second round at the 5,643-yard, par 72 course.

Today, Waters will play Linda Schnoll of Shackamaxon, who advanced by defeating Sue Dilley of Essex County and Rie Noble of Morris County.

Karen Noble of Morris County, who captured the qualifying medal Tuesday, advanced to the round of eight by easily defeating Sheila Solomon of Alpine and Ann Lanyi of Roxitucus by 7 and 6 scores.
