

# WMGA finishes 2d in Griscom Cup golf

HARRISON, N.Y. — The Women's Golf Association of Massachusetts captured the Griscom Cup by winning the team matches for the second year in a row yesterday at the West Course of the Westchester Country Club.

Massachusetts compiled 23½ points under the Nassau scoring system used for the tri-matches. The Women's Metropolitan Golf Association was next with 20½ points, followed by the Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia with 19.

Each team was comprised of seven golfers who competed in threesomes with each golfer playing the other two in simultaneous matches. A point was awarded for each nine and another for the entire 18-hole match at the 6,040-yard, par-74 course.

The WMGA, captained by New Jersey's Helen Aitken of Montclair, was led by Garden Stater Ann Probert of Somerset Hills, who scored 5½ points out of a possible 6. Lee Ann Vogel of Southward-Ho contributed 4½ points. Also competing for the WMGA were U.S. Curtis Cup team member Margaret Plaat, Reggie Hawes and Karen Durkin, all of Westchester, and Debbie Doniger of Fairview in Connecticut. The Griscom Cup Team Matches were inaugurated in 1898.
