

# **Donna Young Wins 2nd GSWGA Stroke-Play Crown**

**Donna Young of Springdale scored 77-74—151 to win the Stroke Play Championship of the Garden State Women's Golf Association on June 10-11 at Preakness Hills.**

**Cathy Reynolds of Glenwood was second at 81-78—159 and Sybil Whitman of Mountain Ridge was third at 80-80—160.**

**Barbara Glucksman of Green Brook won the net championship with a three hole playoff victory over Isa VonHessert of Knickerbocker and Jo Friebley of Bamm Hollow after the three tallied 150. Sandy Silver of Shackamaxon scored 151 and Joyce Allen of Peddie was at 154. Glucksman also tied for fourth low gross with Helen Aitken of Montclair at 162.**

**The Stroke Play Championship Gross Trophy was named for Emily Frelinghuysen Stroke Play Trophy and dedicated to her at the awards ceremony.**

**This trophy is a permanent award and the winner has custody of it until the winner is crowned the following year. Donna Young has won this trophy for the second time consecutively. The trophy begins with the 1990 champion. Emily Frelinghuysen was a founding member of the GSWGA and has been instrumental in establishing its values, by-laws and competitive spirit. She has been involved, personally, with the Elizabeth Goss Round Robin Tournament, held almost exclusively at her home course of Somerset Hills, since its inception in 1954.**
