At 5,646 yards, the Green Brook course provided a fun and exciting golf environment. On top of this, the weather was very pleasant which made for a great day of golf.

At 8:00 a.m. a field of twenty-nine teams began the Sister-Brother Championship. It was a close contest, but Becky Montgelas and her brother, Jeffrey Sweet, were the winners with a gross score of 73. Sheila Torgan and her brother, John Madigan, were second with a score of 75. Nancy Lynch and her brother, Tom Brothers, won Low Net with a score of 66.

At 10:30 a.m. the competitors in the Sister-Sister Championship began to play. For the longest time it appeared there would be a play-off at the score of 82 between Phoebe Timpson and her sister, Wendy Havens, and Lynn Schonbraun and her sister, Carol Rubin. Then
