The first two scholarships were awarded by the WMGA Foundation in 2003. They totaled \$5,000. We are happy to report that with the \$56,000 commitment to the six members of the class of 2023, the Foundation has broken the \$1,000,000 barrier in total scholarships awarded, helping 150 scholars reach their dreams.
